


Agreement Regarding Revisions to the College of Nursing and Health Bylaws


This agreement was signed in May, 2015.

The current College of Nursing and Health (CoNH) Bylaws provide for a Bylaws Committee that includes all TET Bargaining Unit Faculty Members (BUFMs) in the college. In order to facilitate implementation of the recommendations made in Director of Equity and Inclusion Matthew Boaz's July 3, 2014 memorandum to Provost Narayanan, however, the AAUP-WSU and the University agree that, subject to restrictions set forth in Section 10.4.2.1 of the CBA, all proposed revisions to the CoNH bylaws will be considered by the full faculty (all NTE and TET BUFMs of the college) without first moving through committee review.


